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ABOUT THE PROJECT

The project “Green Skills at Vocational Education”(in the field of KA2-Erasmus+ program, supported by the European Commission), stems from the challenges, especially at the European level, of facing the problems of environmental respect and climate change in an innovative and functional way.

For this reason, the project aims to produce recommendations for two categories of workers directly involved in the environmental issue, electricians and builders, aiming to make the labour market and the economy in these two fields more environmentally friendly, respectful of its resources and, consequently, more aware of choices that are made.

Recommendations developed by consortium will be the principal base for the development of a professional curriculum for these categories of workers at an international level, contributing in this way to the realisation of the Europe 2020 strategy, promoted by the European Commission and focused on building a sustainable, resource-efficient, competitive and environmentally friendly economy.

Activities

1. Interviews and questionnaires to vocational educators and trainers, policymakers and employers chosen from within two profiles (electricians and construction workers);
2. Production of a quality report for both the interviews and for the questionnaires;
3. Identification of best practices to be inserted in electricians’ and construction workers’ curricula to improve their academic background;
4. Creation of best practice recommendations for the curricula of both construction workers and electricians.

Objectives

By making recommendations, the consortium is aiming to reach the following objectives:

1. To increase the quality of green skills vocational education and training (VET) in partner countries, increasing awareness of VET systems for green skills education;
2. To increase of the awareness of policymakers, employers, VET trainers and VET students in the sector of green skills;
3. To contribute to the expansion of green skills jobs, and so contributing to the improvement of employment opportunities for workers graduating from partner countries’ VET organisations;
4. To contribute to the European Union strategy of making a greener economy, which is more respectful and aware of the environment;
5. To enhance the commitment at local and regional level (Public Authorities) to a high-quality, inclusive VET offer, with work-based training and the identification of green skills.

RESULTS

1. Increased quality of VET system for green skills education in two different curricula: electricians and construction workers;
2. Expansion of green skills jobs leading to a greener economy and labour market that is aware of its choices;
3. Shared knowledge about green skills, contributing to the Europe 2020 strategy.
